  - Obtaining cut off marks and above

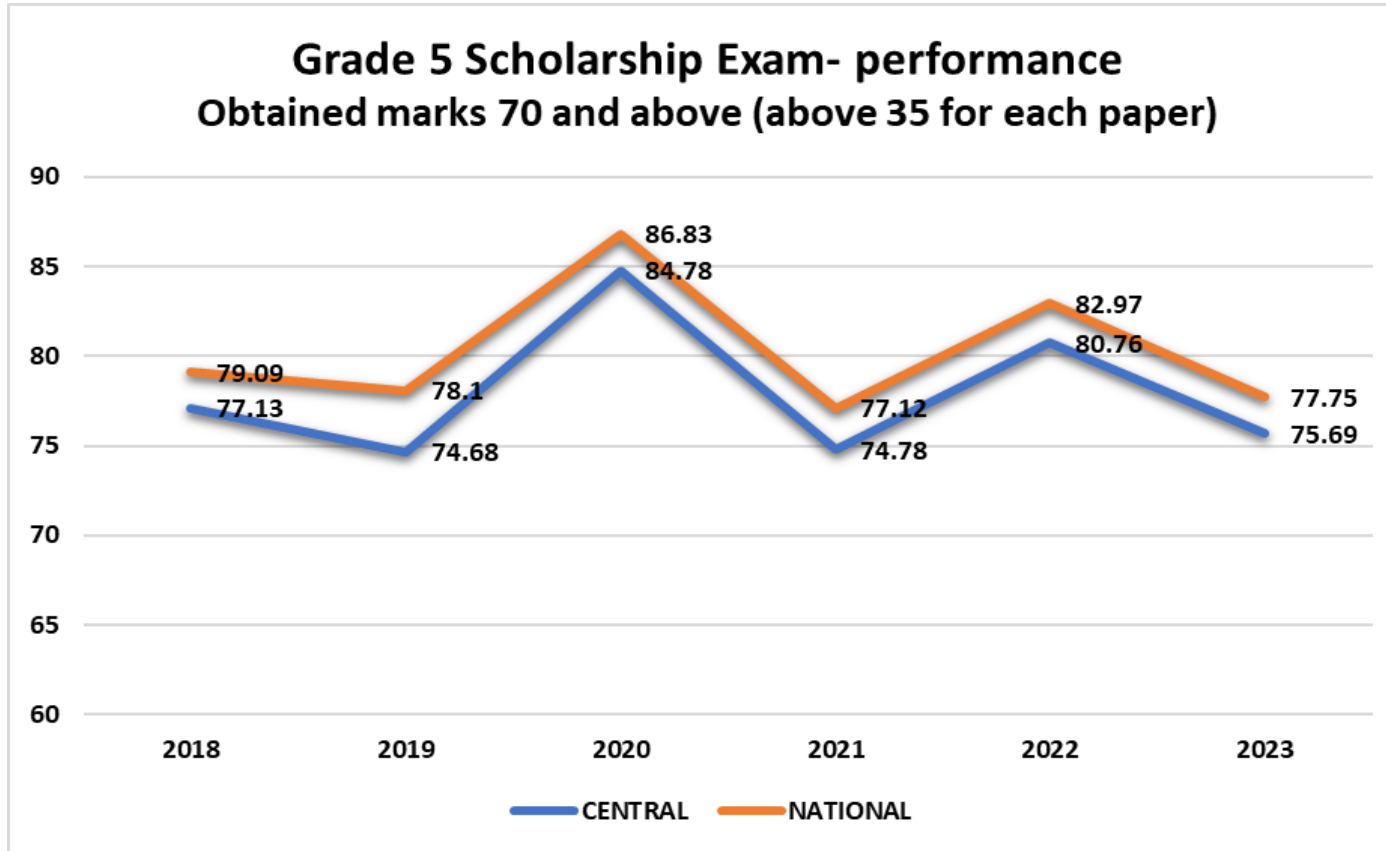

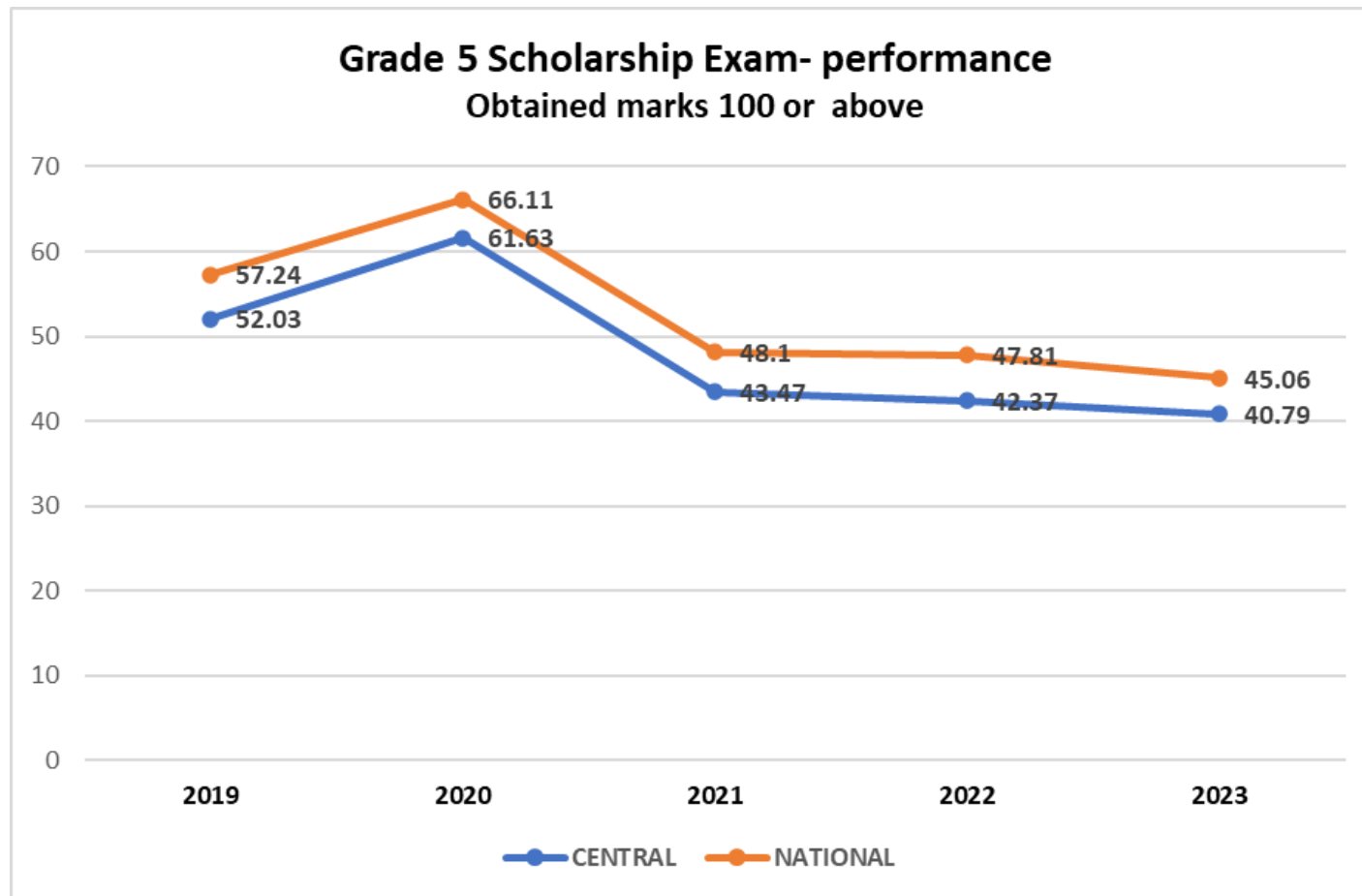

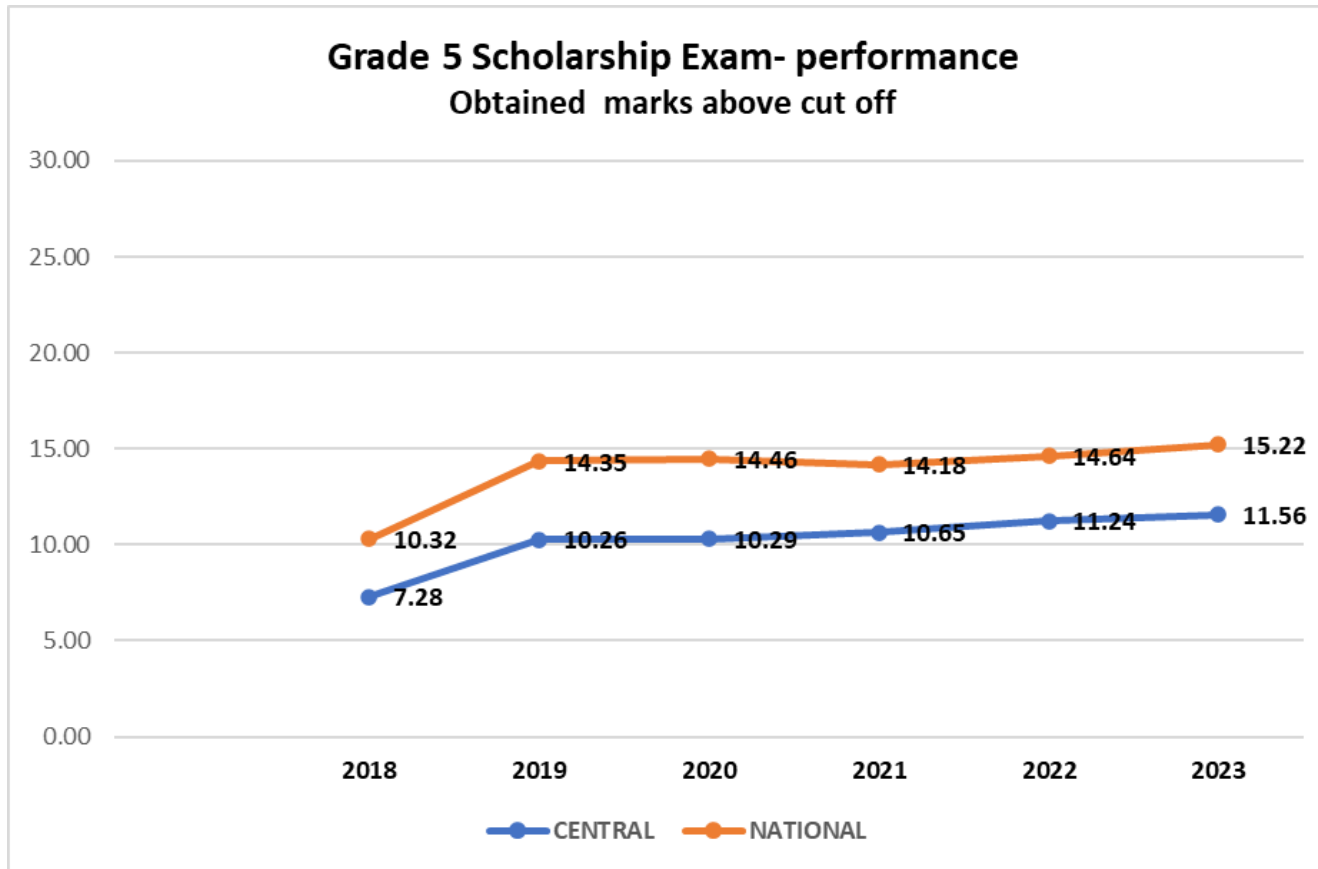
## Performance at Grade 5 scholarship examination -National vs Central in obtaining marks 70 and above.



# Performance at Grade 5 scholarship examination -National vs Central in obtaining marks 100 or above.

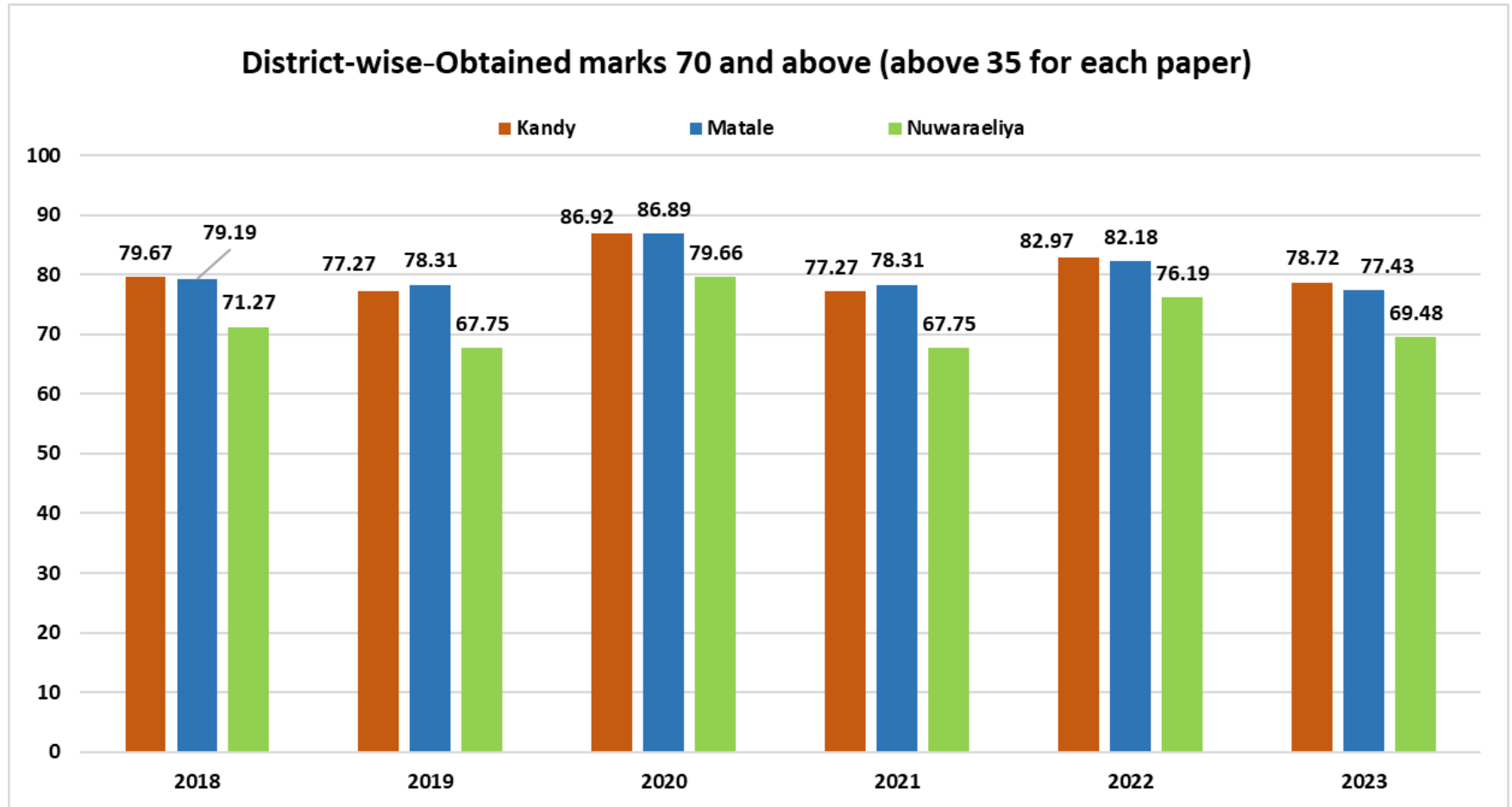


# Performance at Grade 5 scholarship examination -National vs Central in obtaining cut off marks or above.

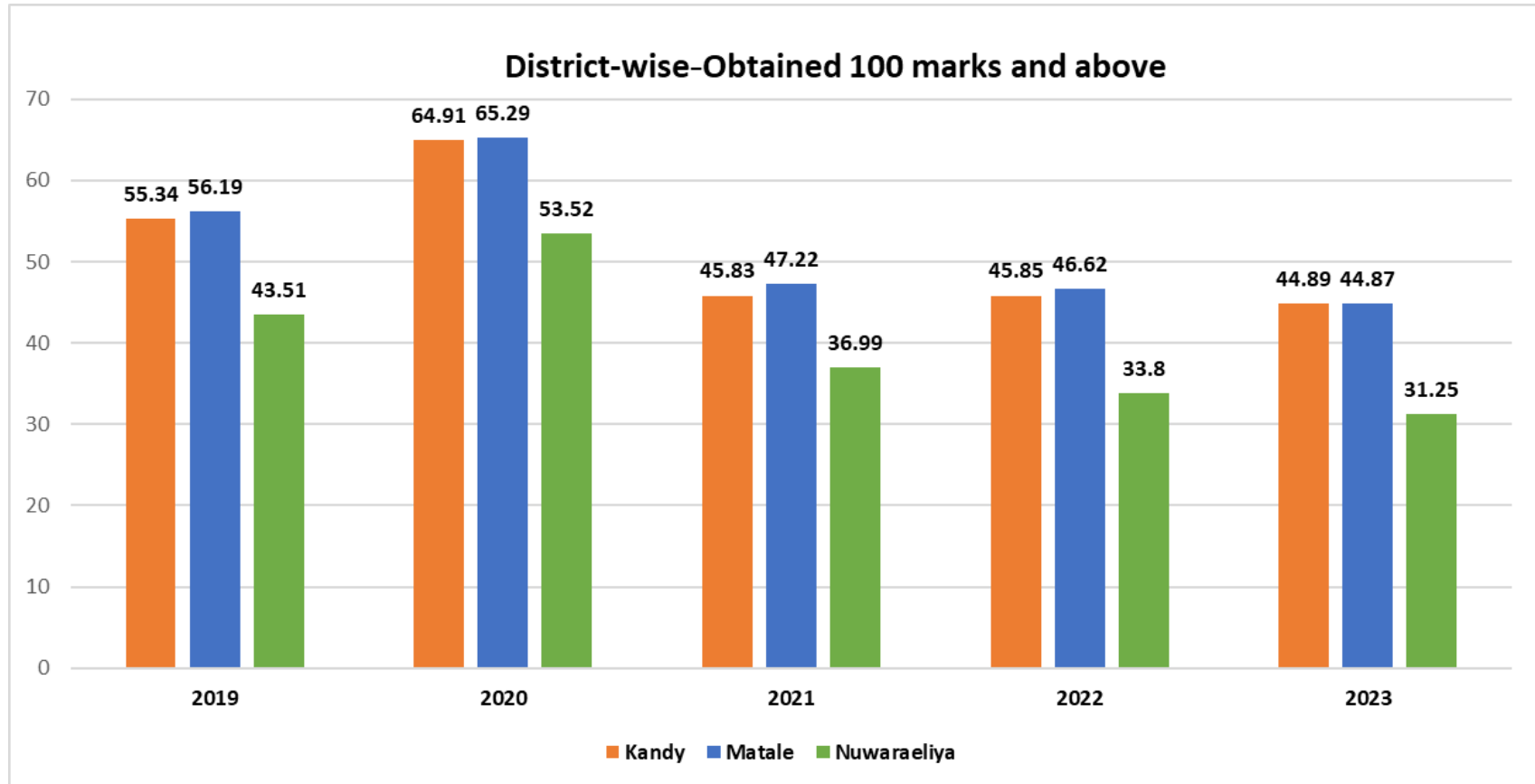




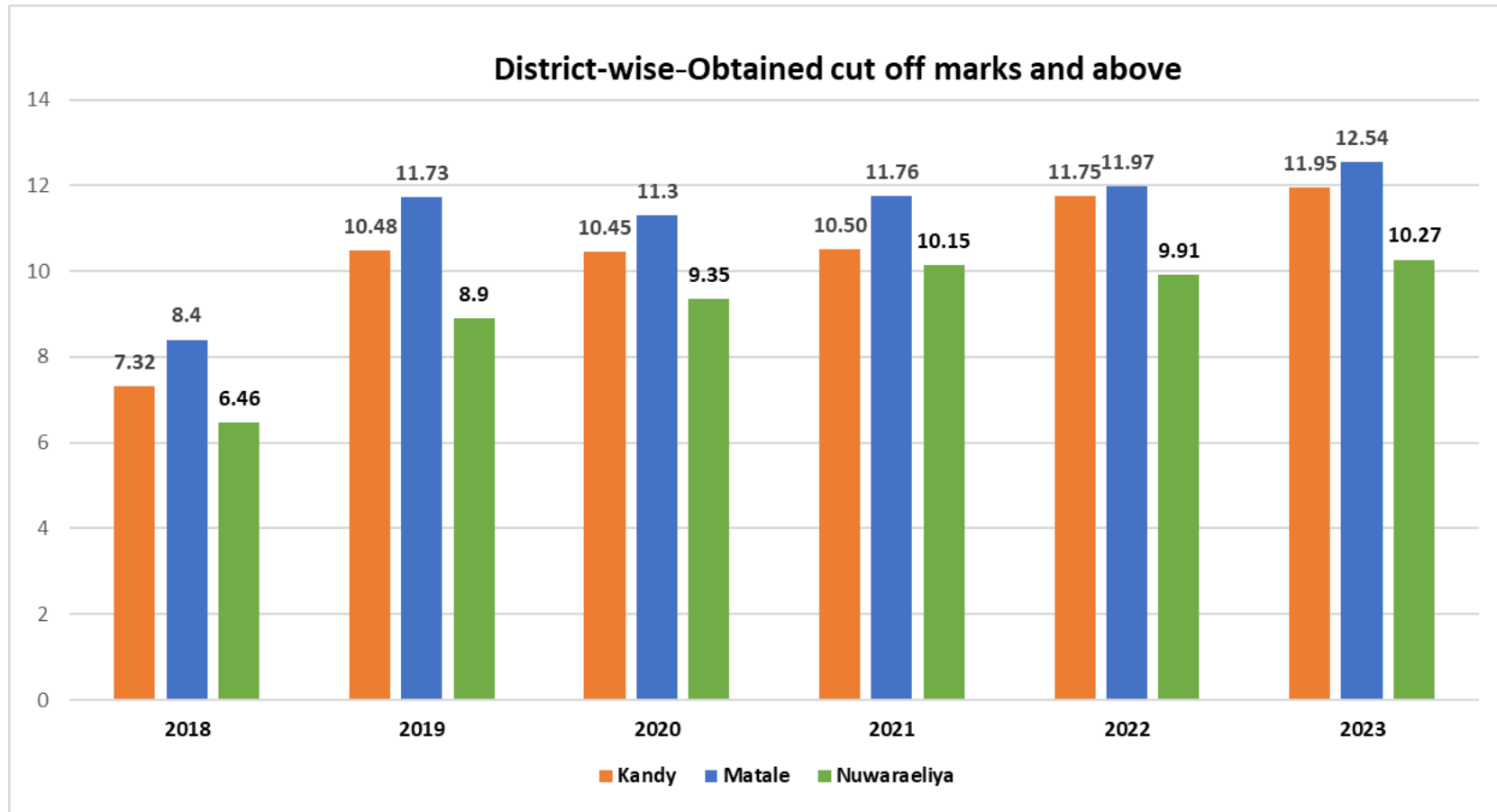
# District wise Comparison of Candidates who obtained marks 70 or above at Grade 5 scholarship examination -2018 to 2023
